There will be a combined Concours and General Membership meeting at the Fiesta Henderson from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm. The General Membership meeting will start at 8:00 pm. We've arranged for a banquet speaker, Ms. Nancy Kapitanoff, who's made a documentary film about the Comet Model Company. She's also the daughter of a man who was the long time West Coast Distributor for Comet Models.
