

# The 2009 Comet Model Champs

## Eligible Models

There will be special awards for the best performing Comet model in each of the 2009 Champs events. You don't have to win the event—you just have to have entered the best performing Comet model in that event. So if your Comet Sailplane places 3<sup>rd</sup> in the C Pylon FF event, you'll get the third place contest plaque—and the special Comet award.

### Notes to Power Model List Above

1. Clipper Mk I is straight dihedral, Mk II is polyhedral.
2. Both sizes of Interceptors had small rudder and large rudder versions.
3. Curtiss Robin would be a good ship for the Gas Scale event.
4. Golden Eagle had low wing, mid wing, and parasol wing versions.
