- SAM R/C assist planes must meet rules of the Society of Antique Modelers <http://www.antiquemodeler.org>
- Four flight lines available.
- Class I, II and III VR/CS Pattern Competition per VR/CS rules, three flights each, awards to third place. Best two of three flights used for scoring.
- VR/CS airplane of the year is the Ed Kazmirski Taurus.
- VR/CS Concours – Note: Planes to be judged must have plans available.
- VR/CS Sport Scale
- VR/CS Open flying
- SAM Concours
- SAM 1/2A Texaco and combined Class A, B, C LER 20 second engine run, best 2 of 3 flights, 8 minute max, no power limitations. Awards to third place.
- Entrants must possess current 2010 AMA membership – VR/CS and SAM membership not required to fly.
- Flying field opens 9:00AM Friday for early arrivals – NOTE: All I/C glow engines must have effective mufflers. Flow through mufflers prohibited. 2-Cycle Engines 95db at 9 ft. 4-Stroke Engines 100db at 9 ft. SAM approved ignition engines may be used per the discretion of the CD. No limitations for electric power.
- Flying field closed 9:00AM to 4:00PM Saturday except for official vintage flying events.
- Field open Sunday to general flying at 10:00AM.
- Lunch available on the field Saturday only.
- Tailgate swap shop – bring your hobby items for sale.
- Saturday Evening Banquet.
