## Roy Robertson Memorial Trophy.

These are the guidlines to be used by any and all C.D.s who may run this particular event.

- 1. The contest will use the CURRENT S.A.M. Rules (Aust) for all events with the following exceptions......(a) Three rounds will be flown in each event and all rounds count.
  - (b) Non S.A.M. affiliated will be eligible for the individual event trophies however they will not be eligible for the overall Trophy.
- 2. The Trophy will be contested at the P.D.A.R.C.S. Flying Field, Wenn Rd. Cardinia (vic) every January. The date will appear on the V.M.A.A. Contest Calender and notified in the S.A.M. Australia Newsletter.
  - 3. The events for the Trophy will be:
    - (a) R.C. Duration
    - (b) R.C. Texaco 1938 cutoff.
  - 4. Scoring will be as per S.A.M. Aust Rules.
- 5. The overall Trophy will be decided by adding the both event scores of each competitor and the highest score overall wins.
  - 6. F.A.I. Cards must be presented to the C.D. before any competitor can fly.
