**President's report**

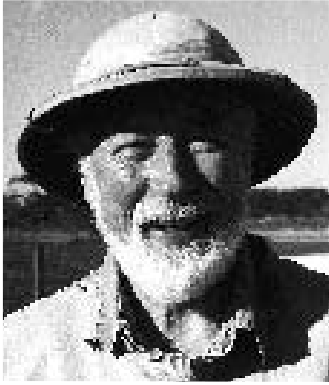

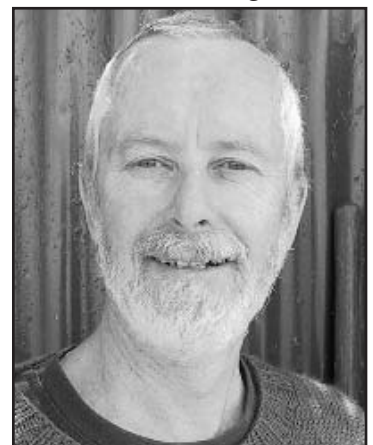

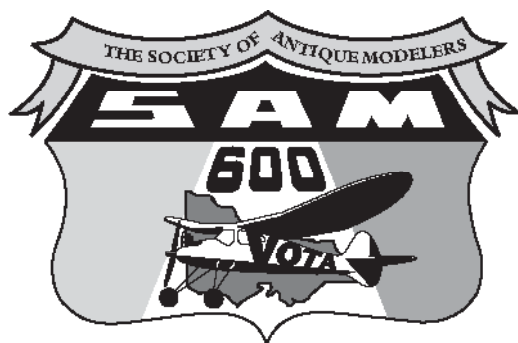
During the a two month period we had 619 visitors to SAM 600 and 322 visitors to the Model Recognition page over 5 weeks. ie., from the start of

1. To comply with the conditions of the MAAA Public Liability Insurance Policy, all contestants must provide a current MAAA/FAI card or proof of membership of an affiliated club by means of an official club receipt for payment of fees, otherwise you will not be permitted to fly.
2. All transmitters are required to have an MAAA Frequency Certification.
3. All entrants must make themselves available to receive free and at no charge, a sponsor's "goodie bag" packed full of modellers' stuff.

### **PRESENTATION / GET-TOGETHER DINNER:-**

Will be held on the Sunday evening, in the Dining Room of Commercial Hotel 91 Campbell Street Swan Hill. The evening will commence at 6:30pm with dinner being served at 7:30pm. (Also Swan Hill has lots of interesting eating places including McDonalds).

Please note:

The landing area will be defined by the contest CD at each contest briefing session. Note no landing circle bonus points will be awarded, as defined in the SAM 600 of Australia Rules.

**INDOOR FREE FLIGHT:-**

This is for FUN, and the flying of any suitable free flight rubber powered aircraft or chuck glider for the sheer fun of it is the sole purpose of this evening. However, for those pilots who enjoy a challenge, there will be an official Hanger Rat event for which trophies will be awarded.

**HANGER RAT:-**

**CONTEST FORMAT:** There shall be five officially timed flights. These flights may take place at any time during the evening up until 10:30pm by which time all flights must be completed. Of the five flights, only the best flight shall count, and the overall winner shall be the contestant with the longest single flight.

Official timed flights are to take place in conjunction with general flying as fun flying WILL NOT be stopped whilst contest flying is taking place.

Remember, this is not serious stuff, this is a fun night for all, especially the kids and other non Old Timer R/C flyers.

**PLEASE NOTE:** All participants are required to wear soft rubber soled footwear, socks or bare feet as this event is being held on a basketball court and VOTA is liable for any damage caused to the polished floor surface. Street shoes are NOT allowed.

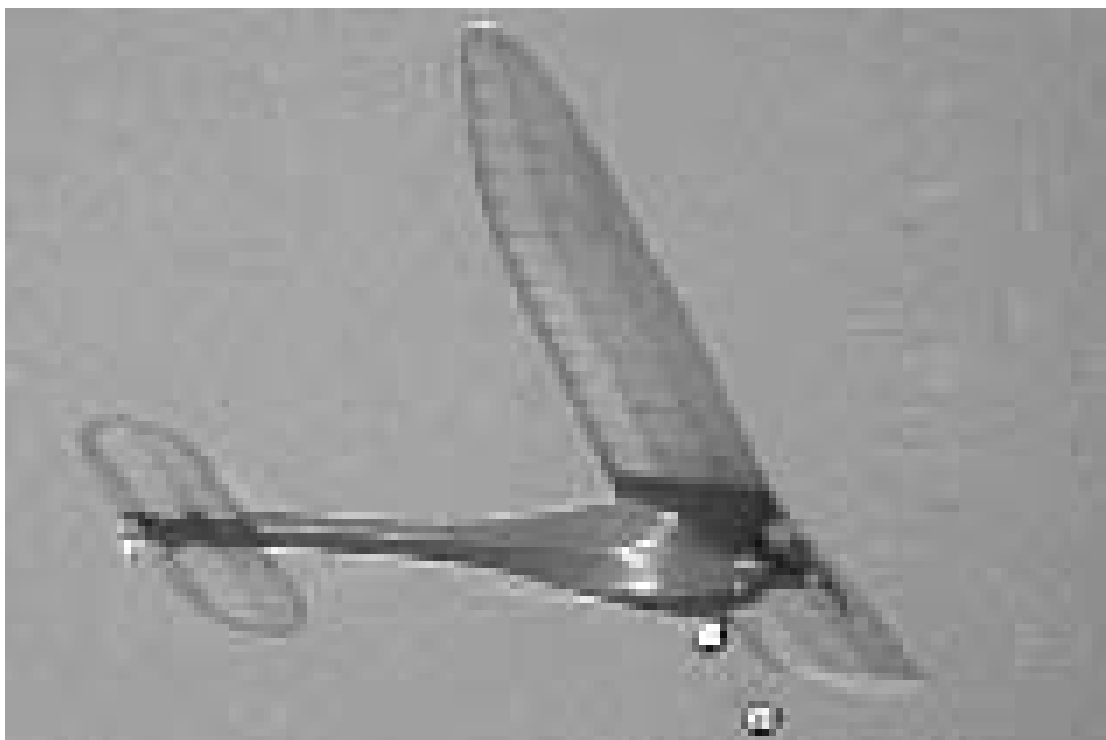
