### Walston TX Housings By Earl Griffith

Walston retrieval systems have enabled me to retrieve models that would have been lost forever. On models with pylons the transmitter can often be placed in the pylon near the center of gravity. However on long fuselage models such as Mulvihills, Moffetts, Nos Wakes and Rubber models I like to place the tx in a housing just aft of the noise block. I do this primarily to shift the CG and make the plane unflyable without the tx being installed. The necessity of mounting the tx on the plane before flying eliminates an impulsive "I'll just try a couple test hops without the Walston....I'm sure there is no lift about."

I make up housings for the tx in batches and keep them around until needed. The average weight of this set of four is .75 gram.

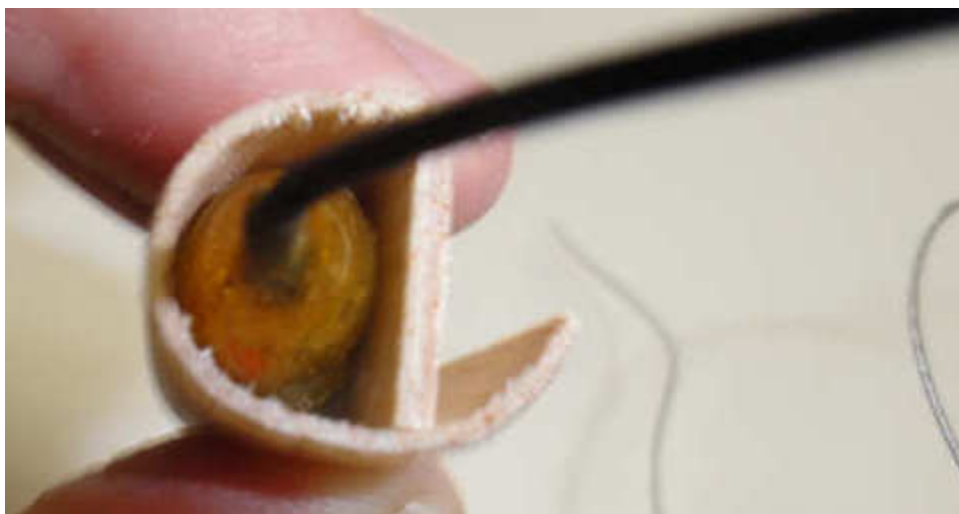


**Figure 3** After soaking 1/32 balsa in hot water, it is wrapped around the drill, secured with scrap rubber, and left to dry.



**Figure 4** The 1/32 balsa tube is cut to length. The rectangles are 1/16 and will serve as the base of the housing.

**Figure 5** Hold the tube segment against the base with the tx in place. When everything looks and feels right, remove the tx and and CA the two together. The excess tube material can then be trimmed.



**Figure 6** Glue a block on to one end of the housing. Carve to shape, sand, dope, sand, dope again and sand lightly.

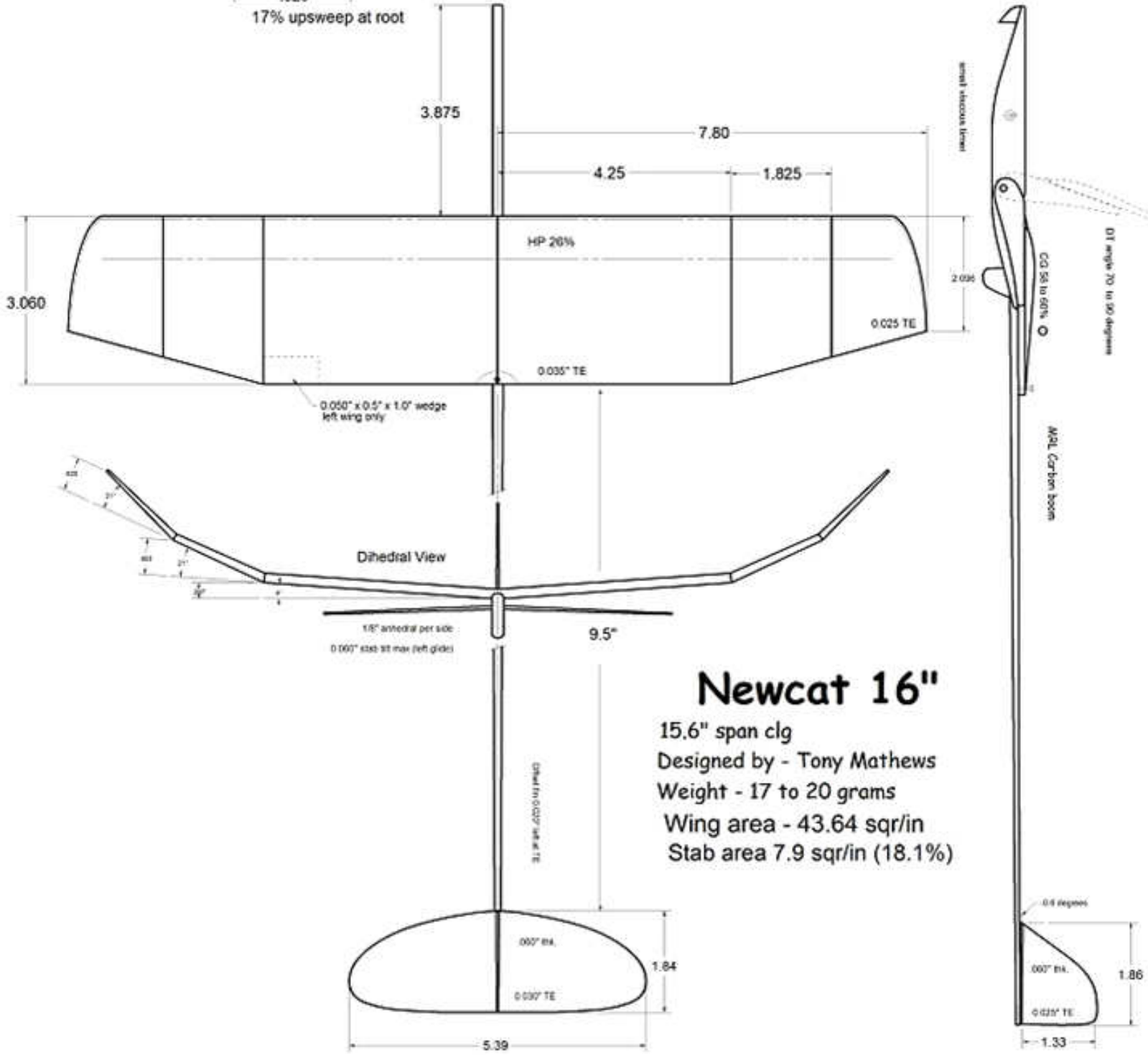
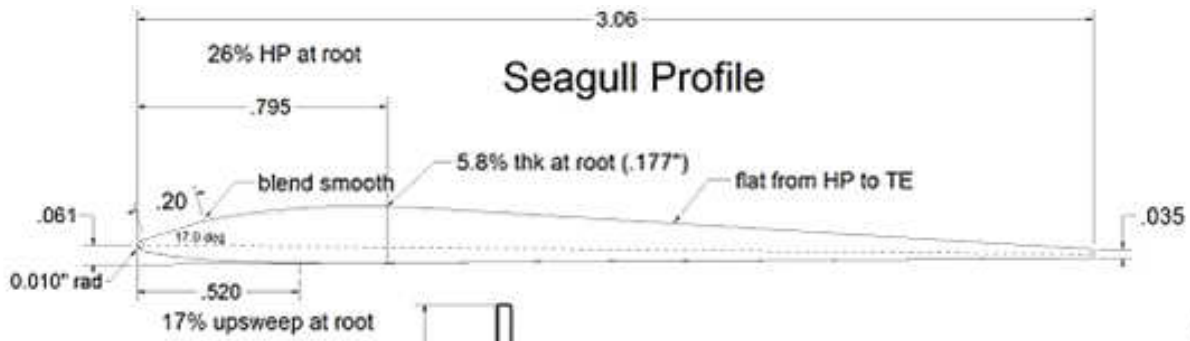
Figure 7 The housings are now covered with very light fiberglass and 30 min. epoxy. Excess epoxy is squeegeed off. I have set the housings up on T pins stuck in my work board while the epoxy sets.



Figure 8 Here is a completed housing in stalled on my Moffett. The excess fiberglass has been trimmed and the housing lightly sanded.
