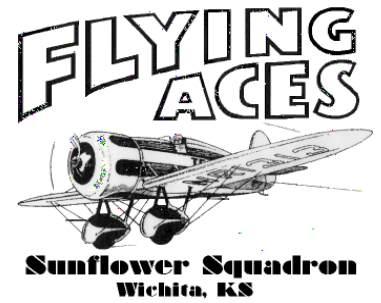

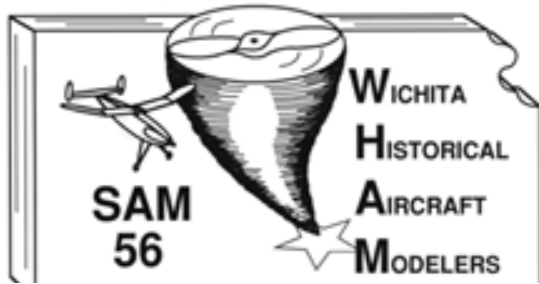
Marty Kline had a 1/4A Strato-streak built from an old RN kit acquired from George A.
